Discussion

- The Ethics Committee of Geneva Hospitals is beginning a reflection on climate change and its impact on the health system.
- So far, the focus has been on adaptation to climate change and its impact on health systems, rather than on prevention from a health system perspective. There is a lack of modeling studies and hypotheses in the health sector on adaptation to climate change. Where we know we can adapt or mitigate is in the emissions of the health infrastructure - but less is known about other adaptation strategies. We are also seeing an increase in the emergence of infectious diseases, and we know the burden this places on health systems. Heat and cold waves also pose health challenges.
- There is a need to combine individual and structural changes to address climate-related health challenges. Social inequalities can pose significant challenges to health systems and require a broader approach.
- Ethicists should reflect on the role that advocacy can play; it can be challenging to avoid greenwashing and ethics washing.
- In June 2023, the Swiss Consortium for Sustainable Health and Ecological Transformation of the Healthcare System was founded. The aim of the consortium is to promote synergies between partners, to make existing efforts visible and to promote innovative ideas that can reduce the environmental impact of healthcare services. In the highly fragmented Swiss healthcare system in particular, cooperation between the various stakeholders and the joint implementation of effective measures poses difficult. The establishment of the consortium is a response to this challenge (Vgl. Further information on the Consortium, [here](#)). More and more institutions and hospitals want to join the consortium
